Review of all RCTs on reporting of adverse events (AEs)

- in three major surgical journals
- published in 2010

	Intraoperative AEs	Postoperative AEs	All AEs	No AEs
Reporting	42%	42%	15%	43%
Classification	9%	54%

Key concerns for recovery and management?


14% of postoperative complications **preventable** with **full compliance with WHO SSC** (95% CI 7% - 21%)

CCI®: Comprehensive Complication Index

pLOS: postoperative length of hospital stay

Aim of CIBOSurg – ClassIntra® for better outcomes in surgery





- Multidisciplinary, multicentric quality improvement project
- 9 hospitals, 5 surgical disciplines
- Systematic recording of iAEs (ClassIntra®)
- (Re-)activation of sign-out with interdisciplinary discussion of iAEs

With the aim to improve:

- postoperative patient outcome
- perioperative collaboration



2023 – Federal quality committee supports context analysis


2024 - Grant from Promedica Foundation for simulation training
